Dinner Money Arrears

As you will be aware, The Dinner Money Debt Recovery Policy was circulated recently. It was set up due to the increasing numbers of dinner money arrears, and so the school could adopt a consistent approach. It is a parent's / carer's responsibility to ensure that their child is provided with either a packed lunch or a school meal, and the school meals should be paid for in advance. Unfortunately, we have seen an increasing amount of dinner money arrears.

We would be grateful if parents and carers could please keep an eye on their accounts and ensure that they are topped up when required. It is possible to create a free email alert on ParentPay when there is a low balance and we will recirculate details on how to do this. If you are experiencing any difficulties paying for lunches please contact the office to discuss this.

This policy does not affect those children who qualify for Free School Meals, nor those in Key Stage 1 who are all currently entitled to receive Universal Infant Free School Meals
