CHANGES TO DATA PROTECTION LAW

You may be aware that from 25th May, new rules around data protection will come into force. The 'General Data Protection Regulation' (GDPR) will change how we can use your personal data and keep it safe. It will also strengthen your rights over your own data.

The aim is to make sure sensitive or private information about you and your children remains safe. While this is similar in many ways to the current Data Protection Act, there are a some differences and we have made a few changes to our in-school procedures to ensure that we are compliant. One of the changes is that we have updated our privacy notice, which is available on the school website <u>here</u>.

DELIVERY OF ITEMS FOR PUPILS TO THE OFFICE

Please could all parents and carers remember to send in with your child everything that he/she needs for the school day. This includes packed lunches, water bottles, sun hats, coats and clothing for PE/clubs. This will reduce the number of interruptions that have to be made to the children in class, as they have to come to the office to collect their belongings. On the rare occasion that a delivery has to be made during the day, please ensure that the item is **clearly labelled**.

Please could all parents and carers ensure that their child brings a water bottle (with drinking cap) and a sun hat to school each day. <u>These should be clearly named</u>. Parents and carers should also apply sun cream to their children before school each day, as an additional precaution, in order to protect them from the sun.

Please note that children are only permitted to wear sunglasses at school if medical evidence can be provided to support the need for the glasses (e.g. a letter from the doctor / optician) or if they suffer from hayfever.
